This year's meeting will be held at the M, which has taken several steps towards environmental stewardship. Energy efficiency and water conservation are paramount in a desert environment. The M uses passive cooling and natural lighting to improve energy efficiency and promotes water conservation by offering a \$5 coupon to guests choosing to re-use towels and linens. The Meeting location also highlights municipal efforts to promote environmental sustainability and green business practices. Las Vegas has adopted some of the most stringent water-conservation regulation in the country and uses less water today than it did 15 years ago despite growth.
